Mr. Lovio,

After several conversations about Microlon and its' benefits I brought a kit from you.

I drive a loaded 2004 F-150 with four wheel drive and a 5.4 Triton V-8. It has 3.73 axle gearing. It has had Mobil One synthetic oil in the crankcase since the third oil change at about 3,500 miles.

The truck had about 114,000 miles on it when I did the Microlon treatment. I drive about 100 miles a day on I-75 and other roads. I was averaging 16.1 miles per gallon for overall driving.

Following the instructions and driving the truck for 100 plus miles and about two (2) hours after putting the Microlon in the crankcase the engine was quieter. Since putting the treatment in the engine I have put over 4,000 additional miles on the truck. My mileage has increased .8 MPG. It is now averaging 16.9 for all around driving.

Doing the math, I have paid for the treat in about three (3) months. That is saving me \$30.00 a month at least on gas. So from now on I can count that money as savings on the fuel bill for all the driving I do.

Thanks again for the counseling on the benefits of the Microlon. I am convincing others to try it and will do me wives' car at the next oil change.
